



### Event Spaces – Fact Sheet and Descriptions

The public spaces at the Coral Gables Museum available for use on a scheduled basis for meetings and social events by the public and private sectors pursuant to guidelines established by the Museum are:

## **Descriptions:**

### **Fewell Gallery**

This grand banquet hall is available during the summer season\* and is perfect for indoor wedding receptions, quinces, fairs, and more. The Fewell Gallery measures 34' x 70' and features 20' high ceilings, bamboo and stone flooring, dramatic spotlights for evening events and filtered natural light through sky lights and windows for daytime events. The double doors from this space lead directly to the outdoor spaces (Loggia, Plaza and Courtyard), allowing for easy transition from space to space. A small kitchenette and bathroom are conveniently located for caterers and guests.

### **Community Meeting Room**

The multi-purpose Community Meeting Room is an ideal venue for luncheons, receptions, informational presentations, large business meetings, workshops and intimate concerts. It features high ceilings with attractive dimmable chandeliers, cork floors and walls, a hanging rail for art displays, motorized wall-mounted screen, overhead projector, wall and floor electrical outlets, and seven windows allowing natural light from Salzedo Street to filter in during the day. The room is conveniently located by the Museum Lobby and restrooms, and the kitchen area, making it comfortable for catered events. The Museum's piano may be made available as well as microphone, lectern, and other A/V equipment for an additional cost.

### **Perrin International Hall**

A perfect space for small meetings or luncheons, the Perrin International Hall offers gallery lighting and windows, terrazzo flooring, electrical outlets and a pulldown screen. A/V package may be added as needed. This hall often features artwork by international artists, creating an exciting cultural setting.

### **Anthony R. Abraham Family Gallery**

This historic space features floor to ceiling windows, gallery lighting, gallery cable hanging system, high ceilings, and terrazzo flooring. Availability limited and dependent upon exhibit schedule.

### **Gallery 109**

This exhibit space features gallery lighting, gallery cable hanging system, ceiling projector, polished concrete and stone flooring, and five windows that let natural light in from the Museum Courtyard. Availability limited and dependent upon exhibit schedule.

## **Courtyard**

The Courtyard is an exterior garden space ideal for a wedding ceremony, baby shower, bridal shower, social gathering, cocktail reception or for a “pre-function” event held prior to the use of another museum room. The Courtyard features coral rock and brick tiles, staircase, fountain, and iron gates. It is tastefully decorated with bistro lights, garden furniture, and a variety of plant life, including a shade tree, palm trees, green and flowering plants, and potted native plants.

## **Rooftop Deck**

If you’re looking for unique, our rooftop deck offers an interesting downtown option. The 800 square foot exterior space on the second level is reached by stairway from the Courtyard. This space is ideal for use in tandem with an event in the Courtyard – for overflow or as a bar area.

## **Loggia**

An open-air covered space featuring coral rock tile flooring, 20’ ceilings, wrought-iron chandeliers, and Mediterranean archways, the Loggia offers an exciting urban space sheltered from the sun and rain. Measuring 17.5’ x 70’, this is an ideal venue for cocktail receptions or small market fair. Located adjacent to the indoor Fewell Gallery as well as the outdoor Plaza and Courtyard, this area can be combined with neighboring spaces to accommodate larger events.

## **Plaza**

The Museum’s Plaza is a large open area at the corner of Salzedo Street and Giralda Avenues, and is a perfect venue for public concerts, outdoor fairs, festivals, and other large outdoor events. It is considered public space. Events held at the Museum are able to extend onto the Plaza, however to close the Plaza for a private event, a special event permit is required. Larger events may also extend to Salzedo Street, and would require a permit for a street closure. The Museum staff will assist with securing the special event permit from the City of Coral Gables.
